CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSAL 1

The Mayor and all City Commissioners currently serve two-year terms, beginning at an Organizational Meeting held at 7:30 PM on the Tuesday following the canvass after the municipal election. This proposal amends the Battle Creek City Charter to provide that the Mayor and all City Commissioners shall serve four-year terms, to begin at an Organizational Meeting on the first Tuesday in December after certification of the election.

Shall Sections 2.4 and 2.9 of the Battle Creek City Charter be amended to provide that the Mayor and City Commissioners shall serve four-year terms, with those terms beginning at an Organizational Meeting on the first Tuesday in December after the certification of election?

KALAMAZOO RESA PROPOSAL

KALAMAZOO REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY SPECIAL EDUCATION MILLAGE RENEWAL AND RESTORATION PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the intermediate school district to continue to levy special education millage previously approved by the electors and restores millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 1.4862 mills (\$1.4862 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Kalamazoo Regional Educational Service Agency, Michigan, to provide funds for the education of students with a disability, be renewed for a period of 6 years, 2027 to 2032, inclusive, and also be increased by .0138 mill (\$0.0138 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2027 to 2032, inclusive; if the millage is approved, the intermediate school district will be authorized to levy special education millage at the rate of 1.50 mills (\$1.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) as previously approved by the electors on May 4, 2021 and, if levied in 2027, will collect approximately \$16,815,446 from local property taxes authorized herein (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2026 tax levy and a restoration of millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?
